

North Stainley Village Hall, Additional Conditions of Hire for the Sale* and Consumption of Alcohol

The supply or sale* of any alcohol shall be by or under the authority of the Hirer, who will ensure compliance with the Licensing Act 2003. **In particular the Hirer will ensure that:**

No alcohol is sold* to or consumed by children under the age of 18, if in doubt proof of age is to be sought.

There is no disorderly behaviour and no drinking contests.

No alcohol is sold* to or obtained for a person who is drunk or poured into a person's mouth.

No one under the age of 18 sells* or supplies alcohol.

No smuggled goods which have been imported without payment of duty or which have been unlawfully imported are on the premises.

Small measures (half pints for beer and cider, 125ml wine glasses and 25ml or 35ml spirit) and free tap water is to be available. Unlimited quantities of alcohol are not to be provided free or in return for a fixed fee.

If the hire is primarily or exclusively for the sale* and consumption of alcohol, no children under the age of 16 are allowed to be present unless they are accompanied by an adult. In any event children under the age of 16 are not allowed to be present after midnight unless accompanied by an adult.

Alcohol is only sold* for consumption on the premises, being the part(s) of the Village Hall which they have hired**. It is only to be sold between the hours of 12 noon and 10.30 pm (11.30 pm on Friday and Saturday). Exceptionally, on Fridays and Saturdays in November and December, New Years Eve and Burns Night, sale may continue until later, if agreed beforehand with the Village Hall Management Committee.

Failure to comply may result in one or more fines under the 2003 Act.

Alternatively the Hirer may use the services of the Holder of a Personal Licence under the 2003 Act (a licensee) who has been approved by the Village Hall Management Committee **or** by a representative of the Village Hall Management Committee or North Stainley Sport and Recreation Trust (at a fee of £16 per hour). In such cases the licensee or representative will control the sale* of alcohol and take responsibility for the above.

In some instances the Village Hall Management Committee may require the Hirer to use such a licensee or committee representative

Notes

* Sale includes supply to members of a club and the provision of alcohol where a charge has been made (eg. for admission).

** Alcoholic drinks are not to be taken outside the premises, for example they are not to be taken onto the recreation ground without specific approval of the Village Hall Management Committee (which will then define the part of the recreation ground on which drink can be consumed).
